




SEMINAR VENUE

HOW TO GET TO CUENCA

BY PLANE. The closest airports to the town of Cuenca are: Madrid Barajas, Valencia Manises and Ciudad Real Central. More information at AENA. (<http://www.aena.es>)


BY TRAIN. The town of Cuenca is located in the centre of the Iberian Peninsula and is perfectly linked to the most important Spanish cities by the National High Speed Train Network: Madrid, Valencia, Alicante, Barcelona, Albacete, Seville, Málaga and.... Cuenca – Fernando Zóbel Railway Station is located around 6km southwest of the town. Bus line number 1 links it with the town center. (<http://www.urbanoscuenca.com/>)

BY COACH. The company Auto-res runs daily services to Cuenca from Madrid's South Station. More information at AVANZABUS. (<https://www.avanzabus.com/>)

BY ROAD. 160 kilometers from Madrid, follow highway A-3 towards Valencia, in Tarancón take the A-40/CU-11 towards Cuenca. We are 198 kilometers away from Valencia on A-3/E-901 towards Madrid, in Minglanilla take the N-301 to Almodovar del Pinar-Cuenca.







ABOUT CUENCA

In the eastern part of Castilla-La Mancha region you will find this town with the UNESCO World Heritage designation for its wealth of monuments. The Cathedral, las “Casas Colgadas” (the Hanging Houses), its many art galleries, its Abstract Art Museum (the centerpiece of the city’s thriving art scene) and medieval cobbled streets charm the most hardened traveller. The town spreads out from atop a promontory winding between the stunningly dramatic gorges carved by two rivers, the Huécar and the Júcar. Meanwhile, below, the modern town grows on the Júcar plain.
